Giving the Gift of Hospice

- Bruising more easily
- Sleeping more
- Increased forgetfulness
- Increase in trips to the ER or doctor's office
- Weight loss
- Decrease in appetite
- Incontinent of the bowel or bladder
- More pain
- Wounds that will not heal
- Shortness of breath
- Increase in medications
- Decreased independence with bathing, meals & eating, walking, dressing, and general hygiene
